# Fire Training and Fuels Crew Expectations

## August 1-10 Training

- Must have **FULL** attendance for all selected trainings to receive certification. Absences cannot be made up and will result in no certificate.
- Work capacity test is strongly recommended for all trainees, but not required.
- Work capacity test will consist of completing a 3-mile walk while wearing a 45 lb. weighted vest in 45 minutes or less.
- We will provide lunch, water, safety equipment, and tools- please wear sturdy hiking boots or work boots, work pants, and long-sleeved work shirt.
- Bring a container for refilling water.

## Fuels Crew Project Assignments (Long-term)

- Must be willing to work at sites for consecutive days, either camping or driving.
- Projects will require physical exertion focused on chainsaw work, controlled burning, brush removal, chopping, digging, lifting, etc.
- Must show up on time and work as a team player.
- Maintain good communication regarding attendance.
- Work safely and maintain a professional attitude that appropriately represents UAIC.
- Attend on-going training and education to improve relevant cultural and ecological knowledge and stewardship related skills.
