Dear Membership of Lone Band of Miwok Indians:

CTTP is providing Non-Recurrent Short Term Benefits for the Pandemic Emergency Assistance Fund (PEAF). This assistance is available to CTTTP Participants who are members of the Lone Band of Miwok Indians who reside in the off-reservation areas of Amador County.

The PEAF Benefit will be available **Thursday, September 1, 2022** through **Friday, September 30, 2022**.

This is only available for households who have not already received PEAF assistance from any Tribal TANF Program or CalWORKS and must have an active case with CTTTP prior to September 30, 2022.

Must meet each item of eligibility:

- 1. Current TANF Participant (Eligible Native American Family as defined in CTTTP Eligibility Policy).**
- 2. Living in Amador County.**
- 3. Participants will need to provide justification by completing PEAF Assessment.**
- 4. Transitional cases are considered CTTTP Participants.**

All PEAF Services are as funds permit and on a first come, first served basis.
