



COMMITTEE CODE OF CONDUCT

The appointed members of Committees of the Ione Band of Miwok Indians shall commit to abide by a high standard of personal conduct in the performance of their duties, and shall adhere to the following:

1. Committee Members shall conduct themselves in a professional and courteous manner at all times while representing the Tribe in the Committee Members' official capacity.
2. Committee Members shall attend external meetings as a Tribal representative only when consistent with the Committee Members' duties and as approved by the Committee Chairperson and/or the Tribal Chairperson.
3. Committee Members shall not have any authoritative or decision-making powers, except as authorized by the Tribal Council.
4. Committee Members shall avoid any conflicts of interest or the appearance of conflicts of interest. A conflict of interest exists when a Committee Member has a personal or financial interest distinct from and adverse to that of the Tribe. No Committee Member shall make, vote on, or participate in making decisions, which involve a personal financial interest, other than an interest held in common by all Tribal citizens, against the best interest of the Tribe. An interest, whether financial or personal, is something that may or will benefit the Committee Member or his or her immediate family, financially or personally, rather than the Tribe as a whole. Personal financial or other interests do not necessarily occur when a Committee Member acts on a matter or issue that results in an incidental benefit to him or her or to his or her immediate family. Interest, whether personal or financial, shall be determined by an objective review of the circumstances surrounding the beneficial action. Committee Members must divulge known conflicts of interest to the Committee Chairperson, or in the case of the Committee Chairperson, to the Tribal Chairperson.
5. Committee Members shall adhere to the laws, policies, customs and traditions of the Tribe.
6. Committee Members shall not conduct Tribal business or represent the Tribe while intoxicated or under the influence of illegal or incapacitating drugs.
7. Committee Members must execute and submit to the Tribal Council the COMMITTEE MEMBER ACKNOWLEDGMENT included herein.
